### **Application Process:**

If you decide to apply to become an Australian Skills group Education Agent you have to:

- Complete the Education Agent Application Form by answering ALL questions
- Provide contact details of two (2) Educational Referees
- Provide proof of Qualified Education Agent Counsellor Certificate PIER (Professional International Education Resources), an online Education Agent training Course (EATC)
- Provide proof of business registration from your country
- Be prepared to undertake a Skype interview

All of the above MUST be in English or translated into English from a notary office in your country. Please send certified copies only as the application documents CANNOT be returned.

## **Assessment of Application:**
