Projecting employment over the next 5 years

Identifying the jobs and skills that will be in demand in the coming years is a great way to choose your career path.

The Government's latest projections show that job growth will be the highest in trade industries compared to jobs requiring higher-level qualifications. While we have found that there will be a wide range of job growth across industries, job types and skill levels, the most growth will be in health services and occupational trades.

Job growth over the next 5 years by industry:

The National Skills Commission's three-year employment projections show four industries, account for almost two-thirds of employment growth forecasts to November 2026.
