Support for apprenticeships and traineeships



The Skilling Australians Fund supports the uptake of additional apprenticeships, traineeships and other employment-related training to improve employment outcomes and meet employer, industry and labour market needs for skilled workers.

On the 16th October 2023, National Cabinet endorsed a landmark National Skills Agreement with States and Territories to boost investment in the Australian vocational education and training system over the next five years from January 2024.

Australian Skills Group is registered to deliver and assess 53 nationally recognised qualifications, units of competency and skill-sets:

- throughout Australia to both local and international students;
- off-shore to those students who prefer not to study in Australia;
- that attract funding and employer incentives for up-skilling workforces through its Preferred Supplier Status with various state and federal governments; and

A custom-built Learning Management System (LMS) that has been developed as an interactive and user-friendly learning tool which facilitates a flexible learning approach for individuals to up-skill or gain a qualification irrespective of their location (on-shore or off-shore) for personal &/or professional development.
